# Being Entrepreneurial 2024: Celebrating Entrepreneurial Learning in Europe










## **Update from Spain**

#### **Spanish Cluster Meet-ups**

The first Spanish Cluster Meet-up in 2024, took place on 22 October. More than forty people signed up for the activity where Alejandro Almeida, from the University of Extremadura, showed participants the main keys to digitalising an SME, how SMEs can improve or boost their success using data as the main unit and easy, affordable digital tools. The second activity is programmed for December, when the Country Cluster will meet with the students taking part in the pilot experience who are interested in the EntreComp4Transition mobility that will be begin in March 2025. Students will be able to meet with the Spanish staff of the project who present the planning of the mobility activity, cities, timetables and main tasks they will commit to as beneficiaries of the founded activity of EU programme. Students' engagement will be boosted by meeting the characteristics of the mobility and knowing the people who support them in case they are selected to put into practice the knowledge and competences, they acquired when making the MOOC, in a real business from one of the countries involved in the project.

# Corporate Sustainability and Sustainability Reporting Certification Programme

On 9 to 11 September 2024, TOBB organised a three day long sustainability certification programme for TOBB affiliated companies, a face-to-face training aimed at helping participants:

- · Learn sustainability-related concepts,
- Increase competence and skills related to reporting and measurement of sustainability,
- Understand sustainability as a concept in a data-supported and application-based manner,
- Support career and competence development processes.

The training focused on: Sustainability Governance, Risk and Opportunities-Scenario Analysis, Sustainability Strategies, Sustainability Performance Measurement Tools, CMB Sustainability Principles, Global Reporting Initiative, Carbon Disclosure Project, International Integrated Reporting Council, Task Force on Climate-Related Financial Disclosures, Sustainability Accounting Standards Board, European Sustainability Reporting Standards (ESRS), Türkiye Sustainability Reporting Standards, Best Practices, Sustainable Financing Tools and Social Impact.
